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Nyawa lebih utama

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■ Penghuni pangsapuri mohon penempatan lebih selesa jika perlu pindah tempoh lama

"Puasa dah dekat dan jika ikut hati memang nak cepat balik rumah. Tapi biar bangunan itu betul-betul selamat," luah warga emas Rohana Mohd Noor yang juga penghuni Blok F di Pangsapuri Taman Keramat Permai, Ampang.

Rohana, 66, antara 222 penghuni yang diarahkan berpindah akibat keretakan

"Saya masih ingat perasaan takut dan seram melihat Blok C pangsapuri itu diruntuhkan walaupun ketika itu bangunan dikosongkan.

Gombak Datuk Seri Mohamed Azmin Ali dipetik berkata, semua rumusan hasil siasatan terbabit diteliti sebelum keputusan sama ada bangunan berkenaan selamatkan atau sebalikinya.

Beliau yang juga Menteri Hal Ehwal Ekonomi berkata, 37 keluarga yang mendiami flat terbabit dijangka boleh kembali ke kediaman masing-masing selewatnya-lewatnya sebelum 1 Ramadan.

Sementara itu, seorang lagi penduduk, Shabnam Shaheer, 37, berkata, mereka lima sekeluarga akur sekiranya tidak dapat menyambut puasa di rumah walaupun segala persiapan menyambut Ramadan dan Aidilfitri hampir siap.

"Selepas berpindah ke flat berkenaan lima bulan lalu, saya berhabis RM2,800 untuk membaiki keretakan, cat dan dekorasi dalaman untuk menyambut Ramadan dan Syawal.

"Rasa terkilan juga, tapi nyawa keluarga lebih penting jadi biar struktur bangunan benar-benar selamat sebelum kami pulang ke rumah," katanya.

Pekerja swasta, Ahmad Fadhil Mohamed, 33, berharap pihak berkuasa menyediakan penempatan lebih sesuai sekiranya penduduk perlu berpindah untuk tempoh lama.

"Bagi masa singkat, mungkin kemudahan di Dewan ini memadai kerana dilengkapi pendingin hawa selain makanan dan minuman juga disediakan tetapi tidak sesuai didiami terlalu lama.

"Maklumlah, bila ada ramai keluarga banyak batas pergaulan perlu dijaga apatah lagi saiz ruang peribadi dalam khemah yang terhad menyukakan urusan seharian," katanya.

Pandangan sama disuarakan Faysal Yusoff, 45, yang berharap kerajaan menyediakan penempatan seperti rumah sementara di kawasan berhampiran.

Temporary housing for flat dwellers

MPAJ identifies units in Hulu Kelang for affected Taman Keramat Permai Flats residents

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AT LEAST 40 units of temporary housing will be available for residents of Block F, Taman Keramat Permai Flats in Ampang if necessary.

Ampang Jaya Municipal Council (MPAJ) president Datuk Abdul Hamid Hussain said the council had identified the units in several apartments in Hulu Kelang should long-term housing prove necessary for the residents.

"For now, we will have to wait for the report that is expected to be out by May 2 before any decisions are made," he said during the council's full board meeting yesterday.

Updating on the residents' situation, Abdul Hamid said 26 families were still staying at the temporary evacuation centre in AU2 Keramat.

"As of Monday night, there were 94 people at the centre, looked after by the Social Welfare Department and Pantas

Selangor," he said.

A total of 222 occupants were forced to evacuate their homes here after 10 large cracks showed on the building.

Selangor State Development Corporation (PKNS) appointed Malaysian Public Works Institute (Ikram) to inspect the building and the results were expected to be revealed soon.

Meanwhile, Abdul Hamid said over 30 compounds were issued to various developers and contractors for failure to adhere to building guidelines for projects in the municipality.

"Their negligence has caused problems like mud floods and flooding, so action was taken against them.

"Where necessary, we even issued stop-work orders so that mitigation works were carried out," he said.

As for the dengue situation in Ampang, he said there were 1,463 reported cases as of April 23, with one death.

There are currently six dengue hotspots in the municipality.
