## 60 venues approved as polling stations for Ampang Jaya and Pandan seats

**Gear up for election**

ALL community halls under Ampang Jaya Municipal Council's (MPAJ) jurisdiction have undergone maintenance and upgrading works in preparation for the 14th General Election.

Council president Abdul Hamid Abdul Hussain said about 60 halls and schools would be used as polling venues for the Ampang Jaya and Pandan parliamentary seats.

"The Dewan Dato Ahmad Razali in Kampung Melayu Ampang and Dewan Perbandaran MPAJ in Pandan Indah will be used as both the nomination and counting centres.

"Repair works like fixing of the roofs, electrical system and installing fans were done at Taman Putra community hall and Dewan Dato Tahir Karim," he said after chairing a full board meeting at MPAJ's headquarters.

He added that the list of halls and schools that will be used had been approved by the Election Commission.

About 38 halls and schools have been designated as polling stations for the Ampang parliamentary seat with 22 venues allocated for the Pandan seat.

He added that MPAJ was mobilising its resources and manpower in preparation for the general election.

"About 900 or 98% of MPAJ staff will be involved in clerical work or general workers, managerial duties as well as observers during nomination and polling days," Abdul Hamid said.

In an unrelated matter, Abdul Hamid said disabled homeowners will enjoy a 50% special relief off their assessment tax for their properties as per a directive from the state government.

"To date we have approved 31 applications since 2017. However, the discount is only applicable for 2017 and 2018 fees," he said.

The council has opened up applications for Ramadan bazaar permits, with a total of 1,501 lots available in 23 locations throughout the municipality.

Meanwhile, the council recorded

a total of 319 dengue cases with one death so far this year.

Three locations have been identified as dengue hotspots – including several areas in Pandan Perdana, Jalan Jelatek and Taman Ukay Perdana.

Measures to control the spread have been taken, including search-and-destroy (breeding ground), Clean Back Alley – Aedes Free Programme as well as the Zero Larvae Operation with the Hulu Langat and Gombak Health Department.

**Getting there**  
Bukit Batu Chondong, Jalan Taman Zooview, Kampung Kemensah, Ampang Jaya. To get to the trailhead search for Bukit Batu Chondong (entrance) on Google Maps

FOLLOWING the closure of Tabur East/West to hikers, a lesser-known peak along the Tabur ridge, named Bukit Batu Chondong (BBC), is now being discovered by hikers. Access is via Kemensah, heading towards the all-terrain vehicle (ATV) area after Zoo Negara.

The trailhead is just beside the road, near the mountain bike (MTB) centre. As it is a narrow, windy road, we were careful to park at a spot that would not obstruct traffic.

Our adventure to this obscure Tabur cousin starts with an uphill climb following a chain link fence on the left. Heads low, we ducked our way through a dense bamboo grove. A signpost pointed the way to the peak (straight ahead) or to the Batu Asah waterfall on the left.

We stayed on target and soon encountered our first obstacle, a narrow climb between two boulders, along the edge of the drop. The path

turned inward as we scrambled up more rocky surfaces. Rounding a final corner, we were confronted by a 5m rock wall.

On the far right, a tree with thick trailing roots appeared to be our ticket to the peak. Using the ropes and roots, we climbed up, squeezing into the tiny space between the tree and rock, before hoisting ourselves up over the rock onto the narrow ledge. It took 10 minutes for all five of us to get past this portion.

At the top, we saw an extended peak on a nearby outcrop. Getting there required scrambling up and down more rocks to reach the 260m viewpoint. The skeletal trees on this small, uneven, rocky mound made a stark contrast against the green backdrop of forest and prominent quartz ridge.

Heading back down, we found an alternative and faster route. Securing ourselves with the rope, we descended the vertical drop by lowering ourselves, bracing our feet on the side of the rock and it barely took a minute.

Spotting another peak along the ridge on the opposite side, we made another five-minute detour and were rewarded with yet another view of the Tibuwangsa range.

The return journey was quick, with everyone clearing the rocky portions easily. Back at the signpost, we headed down the waterfall route. Lined with tall bamboo trees, the dirt trail got wider, marked with deep ruts due to ATV activity. While the undulating terrain was not strenuous, we turned back after 15 minutes due to time constraints.

BBC is a short but interesting hike with challenging obstacles. A hike to the summit takes 20 to 30 minutes. Set aside at least one hour for a round trip to explore all the peaks along the ridge.

## 淘汰舊垃圾車 · 引進日本技術

# MPAJ與KDEB 簽7年合約

(安邦再也23日讯) 安邦再也市议会与达鲁益山垃圾管理有限公司 (KDEBWM) 签署为期7年的公共区域清洁服务合约，该公司承诺更新运作模式加为服务，所有承包商将采用日本的先进垃圾车与扫路集尘机，解决老旧垃圾车常损坏的问题。

新的垃圾车安装有闭路电视、车辆监测系统 (VMS) 和全球定位系统 (GPS)，在路上移动行驶时，该公司位于莎阿南总部的监控中心将全程监督，垃圾车数量有85辆。

安邦再也市议会主席阿都哈密指出，新的垃圾车可以解决以往垃圾车不足、老旧垃圾车经常损坏及漏水漏出的问题，他希望随著市议会与该公司签署合约后，双方合作提供优质的收垃圾服务，确保安邦再也社区乾净整洁。

他今日出席安邦再也市议会与达鲁益山垃圾管理有限公司签署合约仪式，这样指出。

出席者包括代表雪州大臣的雪州高级行政议员拿督依斯干

达、行政议员欧阳捍华，两人在会上见证阿都哈密与达鲁益山垃圾管理有限公司总经理南利莫哈末达希签署合约。

阿都哈密指出，双方签署合约后，藉助该公司的“智慧垃圾管理”运作，市议会将迈入垃圾管理的新纪元。
