Kuala Lumpur 'menangis' lagi

Hujan lebat selama dua jam jejas enam lokasi di sekitar Lembah Klang

Hujan lebat selama lebih dua jam petang semalam sudah cukup untuk menenggelamkan beberapa lokasi di ibu kota selain mengakibatkan banjir kilat sekitar Lembah Klang.

Ketua Pusat Gerakan Operasi Jabatan Bomba dan Penyelamat Kuala Lumpur Samsol Maarif Saibani berkata, pihaknya menerima laporan berhubung banjir kilat di enam lokasi sekitar pusat bandar ini.

"Lokasi yang terjejas adalah Taman Sri Rampai, Jalan Sentul, Batu Muda Tambahan, Persiaran Ampang Hilir dan Jalan Pudu berhampiran Hospital Tung Shin di sini.

"Hujan lebat sejak jam 3 petang tadi (semalam) menyebabkan air bertakung di enam lokasi berkenaan sekali gus mengakibatkan kesesakan lalu lintas luar biasa," katanya.

Sementara itu, Penolong Pengarah Operasi Jabatan Bomba dan Penyelamat Selangor Mohd Sani Harul berkata, pihaknya menerima laporan kejadian banjir kilat berhampiran Sekolah Kebangsaan (SK) Hulu Kelang, di sini, berikutan air Sungai Klang dan Sungai Gisir me-

"Kejadian itu menyebabkan 10 rumah berhampiran sungai dinaiki air. Bagaimanapun, tiada mangsa diarahkan berpindah.

"Pada masa yang sama, banjir kilat menjejaskan laluan jalan Lingkaran Tengah 2 (MRR2) berdekatan Hulu Kelang," katanya.

Mohd Sani berkata, tiga lorong laluan di MRR2 dinaiki banjir kilat menye-

babkan kenderaan ringan dari arah Ampang tersekat dan tidak dapat menuju ke Gombak.

"Bagaimanapun keadaan kembali pulih selepas banjir mulai surut beberapa jam kemudian," katanya.

Flash floods after downpour cause massive traffic congestion

KUALA LUMPUR: A two-hour downpour in the Klang Valley yesterday caused flash floods in many areas, resulting in massive traffic congestion.

The heavy rain, which began at 3pm yesterday, caused many roads in the city centre, including major highways, to be inundated and temporarily halted traffic.

City Fire and Rescue Department operations chief Samsol Maarif Saibani said among the roads that were affected were Jalan Tun Razak, Jalan Pahang, Jalan Genting Kelang, Jalan Batu Muda Tambahan, Jalan Kuching, Jalan Ampang, Jalan Mahameru, Jalan Duta, Jalan Sultan Ismail, Jalan Maharajalela, Jalan Raja Laut, Jalan Syed Putra, Jalan Dutamas, Jalan Ipoh, Jalan Tun Sambanthan, Jalan Sentul and several other areas in the city.

He said the heavy rain caused several trees to be uprooted in the city centre, but no major incidents were reported.

In **Selangor**, 10 houses in Jalan Hulu Kelang were inundated as water levels at Sungai Klang and Sungai Gisir rose during the downpour, causing them to overflow.

Selangor Fire and Rescue Department assistant director Mohd Sani Harul, however, said nobody was relocated.

It was also reported that several low-lying areas in the state were temporarily flooded during the rain.

Twitter user Nur Atiqah tweeted that the road from Gombak to the Middle Ring Road 2 (MRR2) was flooded, and all three lanes were temporarily impassable.

"Whoever is driving from Gombak towards MRR2, please use another route."

"Flash flood in front of Petronas, just 300m after Zoo Negara. All three lanes impassable," she posted.

During the heavy rain, the Smart Tunnel was closed to traffic until further notice as the storm-water management system was put into action.

A Kuala Lumpur City Hall traffic spokesman said floodwaters receded at 6.30pm, and vehicles were able to use the roads as usual.

HULU KELANG – Sebanyak 10 rumah di sini, dilanda banjir kilat ekoran hujan lebat petang semalam.

Penolong Pengarah Operasi Bomba Selangor Mohd Sani Harul berkata, siasatan awal mendapati banjir kilat berpunca daripada limpahan air daripada sungai berhampiran kira-kira jam 3 petang.

“Ketinggian air dianggarkan kira-kira 0.3 meter, hujan lebat di kawasan terbabit menyebabkan air Sungai Kelang melimpah, dalam

masa sama air dari Sungai Gisir juga masuk ke Sungai Kelang.

“Tebing sungai sebelah kiri berhampiran sebuah sekolah kebangsaan adalah rendah berbanding sebelah kanan dan menyebabkan air melimpah ke kawasan tersebut,” katanya.

Beliau berkata, setakat ini tiada aktiviti perpindahan penduduk dilaporkan.

“Bagaimanapun, kita akan melakukan pemantauan dari masa ke semasa,” katanya.

Flash floods hit Gombak

KUALA LUMPUR — Flash floods struck several areas in the city yesterday, the worst being Bukit Antarabangsa in Gombak.

The rain started at about 3.30pm and caused water levels to rise to 0.3m in some areas.

Selangor Fire and Rescue Department deputy director of operations Sani Harul said at least 10 houses in Bukit Antarabangsa were affected.

He said the areas near SK Hulu Klang were inundated after Sungai Kelang overflowed its banks.

The floods caused traffic congestion on the Middle Ring Road 2 (MRR2) heading to Zoo Negara.

Other areas hit were Jalan Sentul, Batu Muda Tambahan, Persiaran Ampang Hilir and the Police Training Centre (Pulapol) in Jalan Semarak.

Pulapol staff Fazril Aznil, 24, said several religious classrooms were submerged with waist-high water levels.

"The situation improved after rain began to recede at 6pm," Fazril told Bernama.
