Sultan Selangor tanam tunjuk langit

CYBERJAYA 21 Julai - Sultan Selangor Sultan Sharafuddin Idris Shah hari ini berkenan menanam pokok *swietenia macrophylla* atau nama tempatannya tunjuk langit sempena program Tanam Pokok Dalam Bandar Peringkat Negeri Selangor yang berlangsung di sini hari ini.

Tengku Permaisuri Selangor Tengku Permaisuri Norashikin pula berkenan menanam pokok *delonix regia* atau semarak api manakala Raja Muda Selangor Tengku Amir Shah pula menanam *caesalpinia sappan* atau lebih

dikenali dengan nama sepong. Terdahulu, keberangkatan Sultan Sharafuddin dan Tengku Permaisuri Norashikin ke program berkenaan disambut Tengku Amir dan Menteri Besar Selangor Amirudin Shari.

Sebanyak 1,500 pokok teduhan dan 3,000 polong renek ditanam oleh 2,000 peserta yang terdiri daripada penjawat awam, penuntut institusi pengajian tinggi awam dan swasta, pelajar sekolah dan wakil pertubuhan bukan kerajaan (NGO) dengan melibat-

kan kawasan seluas 58,669 meter persegi dalam program tersebut. Amirudin dalam ucapannya berkata, program itu diadakan selaras dengan titah Sultan Selangor agar pokok-pokok hijau ditanam secara meluas di seluruh negeri.

Katanya, baginda juga telah berkenan agar penghijauan alam sekitar hendaklah menjadi suatu perkara berterusan yang mana semua pihak perlu mengambil tindakan untuk menanam lebih banyak pokok.

GANGGUAN bekalan air berjadual melibatkan tiga juta pengguna di Selangor dan Lembah Klang akan dilaksanakan semula sebaik sahaja pemulihan Loji Rawatan Air (LRA) Sungai Selangor selesai.

Ketua Jabatan Perhubungan Pelanggan Pengurusan Air Selangor Sdn. Bhd., Abdul Raof Ahmad berkata, pengumuman tarikh yang sebelum ini ditetapkan pada 23 Julai akan diumumkan dalam masa terdekat.

"Sehingga pukul 6 petang ini, pemulihan loji akibat pencemaran bau di Sungai Liam, Batang Kali, Hulu Selangor sudah mencapai tahap 94 peratus.

"Kita jangka kerja pemulihan selesai hari ini atau esok dan orang ramai diminta bersedia untuk berdepan gangguan bekalan air berjadual seperti yang diumumkan sebelum ini," katanya ketika dihubungi *Utusan Malaysia*, hari ini.

Abdul Raof berkata, penangguhan gangguan berjadual yang diumumkan kelmarin dilakukan untuk tidak membeban dan meminimumkan jumlah pengguna terputus bekalan.

Bagaimanapun kerja-kerja penambahbaikan Loji Rawatan Air Sungai Selangor Fasa akan dijalankan seperti dirancang.

"Sehubungan itu kita minta orang ramai sentiasa prihatin kepada pengumuman Air Selangor," katanya.

Ketua Pegawai Eksekutif Air Selangor, Suhaimi Kamaralzaman sebelum ini berkata, gangguan selama 36 hingga 84 jam itu akan melibatkan 785 kawasan termasuk Petaling, Klang, Gombak, Kuala Lumpur, Hulu Selangor dan Kuala Selangor.

Gangguan bekalan air tersebut dijangka menjadi krisis air kedua dan antara yang terbesar tahun ini.

Sementara itu, Pengerusi Suruhanjaya Perkhidmatan Air Negara (SPAN), Charles Santiago pada Rabu lalu, memberi tempoh 84 jam untuk pihak Air Selangor menyelesaikan kerja-kerja penambahbaikan LRA SSP1 bagi mengurangkan impak kepada pengguna.

Dalam amaranannya, beliau menegaskan pihak pengurusan tertinggi Air Selangor itu wajar dirombak sekiranya tidak dapat menepati jangka masa yang disepatutnya.

Tournament enjoying brisk ticket sales

Some 70,000 football fans expected to turn up at Shah Alam stadium next month

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A TOTAL of 70,000 football fans are expected to flood Shah Alam Stadium to watch Selangor and Singapore clash for the Sultan of Selangor's Cup 2019 (TSSC) on Aug 24.

Organising chairman Tan Sri Abd Karim Munis said sale of tickets was brisk with orders received from various parties.

Last week, the organising committee handed over 12,000 tickets to Shah Alam City Council (MBSA) and Ampang Jaya Municipal Council (MPAJ) which will be distributed to council staff as well as local communities.

Abd Karim said past editions of the tournament were popular because of the carnival-like atmosphere.

"What makes this prestigious tournament different from others is the atmosphere.

"Football fans can bring their whole family for a good time," he said after presenting the 4,000 purchased and 3,000 complimentary tickets to Shah Alam mayor Datuk Haris Kasim.

"I am confident that with the support and encouragement given by everyone, this year's edition will see a full house.

"We hope to repeat the same result as last year's tournament where we won all three trophies," he added.

The week-long promotional tour also saw the committee visiting MPAJ headquarters to hand over 3,000 tickets and an additional 2,000 complimentary tickets to council president Datuk Abdul Hamid Hussain.

Abdul Hamid said he was expecting a lot of support from the people of Ampang Jaya for the tournament.

"This is in line with MPAJ's efforts to instill a love of sports within the community," he said, adding that the tickets would be distributed to MPAJ staff, football clubs and residents associations.

"We hope that they in turn will help promote the event to others. This will be a good opportunity for families and sports enthusiasts to cheer on their favourite players."

Aside from the football matches, the other attraction of this year's edition is the lucky draw that will be offering attractive prizes, including a brand-new Honda City, Harley Davidson 833 Iron as well as a 3D/2N stay at Marriott Kota Kinabalu.

"There will also be performances and a fireworks display on the night," Abd Karim said.

Last year, Selangor swept all three cups at the Shah Alam Stadium, with the Selangor Selection and Veterans beating their counterparts on penalties while the Under-16 players delivered a 2-0 victory.

This year's first match will see the Singapore-Selangor Schools Challenge featuring students in the Under-15 group instead of the Under-16 like last year, followed by the curtain raiser between the veterans before the main match.

The tournament's next promotional event will be a meet-and-greet session with the Selangor Selection and Veteran players at the SACC Mall foyer in Shah Alam at 3pm on July 27.

A special promotion for ticket sales will be held on that day along with a display of the grand lucky draw prizes.

Additionally, there will be TSSC jerseys to be won through a quiz.
