■武吉蓮花苑蓮花苑居民不满一个花园内，竟豎

說好不再安裝卻動工 電訊塔 到底拆不拆？



■電訊塔與民宅非常接近，不符合當局列出的指定距離。

（安邦22日訊）不是說好拆除電訊塔嗎？武吉蓮花苑蓮花苑2/5路的電訊塔，昨日再度展開安裝工作而觸動居民神經，要求當局在該問題上取得一勞永逸的方法，勿再典當居民健康。

當地居民告知，自從當地豎立一座，啟用至少5年的電訊塔后，這期間內至少有8人患癌，其中3人病逝，若未來再增加一座，難以想像大家的健康會受到怎樣的影響。

居民促全面拆下

居民曾在去年聯同蓮花苑區州議員張菲倩，公開表態反對后，有關工程隨即靜了下來，直至昨日早上10時，疑是承包商返來安裝發射儀器，居民即聯絡安邦再也市議員莫哈末。

據了解，莫哈末證實承包商在未获批的情況下安裝發射儀器，對方之后也只好拆下已裝上的儀器，才讓居民松一口氣。

該區居民今日透過民政黨蓮花苑州選區協調官劉博文召開記者會，要求張菲倩解釋，去年答允過居民，電訊塔不會建起的承諾。

居民說，上次的記者會上表明會拆除電訊塔，張菲倩表明不會讓承包商裝上帶有輻射的儀器，但至今都沒看到相關單位拆下電訊塔的结构，让人有感投诉无效。

“電訊塔结构一天未被拆下，居民都会提心吊胆，所以最好是全面拆下，包括旧有的那座。”

劉博文：將致函通訊委會

劉博文將致函大馬通訊及多媒体委员会，询问有关电讯塔工程是否获得批准。他也会询问市议会，电讯塔是否获得批准，若又是谁给予批准。

“若有必要，我们不排除与清真寺的负责人会面，商讨电讯塔事宜。”

他指出，根据标准，电讯塔与民宅必须保持80公尺的距离，但新一座的电讯塔，估计只有20公尺左右。刘博文呼吁居民一同监督，避免电讯塔的发射仪器再次装上。

他谴责张菲倩，在答应居民会拆除电讯塔的事情上不负责任。

“张菲倩在州议会上，也没履行人民代议士的责任，缺席了行政议员回答一些有关莲花苑选区的问题。”

未有行動

★林友仁（居民，58岁）担忧电讯塔产生的辐射，影响家中大小成员健康。去年向州议员投诉后，对方说会拆除，新闻也见报了，但至今都没有实际行动。

悄悄動工

★陈来明（居民，70岁）承包商于周二前来安装仪器后，就马上联络邻居，要求对方联络市议员莫哈末。只要电讯塔的结构未被拆除，我们都得担忧，担心承包商每隔一段时间，就会悄悄到来动工。

兒子進院

★姚珍愛（居民，55岁）自电讯塔装上后，感觉大家都被影响，儿子在新年后更是进出医院多次。州议员曾答应居民，不让承包商装上带有辐射的仪器，甚至会采取建筑结构，但现在都未见行动。

Stamping Yap Ah Loy's mark in history

KUALA LUMPUR: Yap Ah Loy's portrait will be immortalised in 2,000 commemorative stamp sets.

The sets, honouring Yap Ah Loy as the third "Kapitan Cina" of Kuala Lumpur, have been launched. They are the result of a partnership between Pos Malaysia and a committee comprising several Chinese associations.

Launched in conjunction with Yap's 180th birthday, each set comes in an envelope with an information pamphlet about him and five stamps bearing his portrait. If the stamps are well received, new designs will be created every year.

Datuk Kevin Lai, who is the memorial ceremony organising committee chairman, said the objective is to preserve the history of Yap's contributions to Malaysia. "We also want to promote his

name locally and internationally," said Lai during the launching of the stamp sets at the Kuala Lumpur and Selangor Chinese Assembly Hall yesterday.

He revealed that discussions were held between several Chinese associations and Yap's descendants on building a museum in Serdang to display items that had belonged to Yap.

Yap Wai Ming, the great-great-grandson of Yap, said the descendants are happy that the stamps have been launched.

"Many have forgotten the history and contributions of this great man. Without Yap Ah Loy, there will be no Kuala Lumpur," he said at the ceremony.

The Kapitan Cina played an important role in the development of Kuala Lumpur, transforming it

from a tin mining town to a major commercial centre in the 1800s.

His notable contributions include helping to end the Selangor civil war in 1873 and rebuilding town buildings in what would be Brickfields in 1881.

Yap, a Hakka from Huizhou, was born on March 14, 1837. He left China for Malacca when he was 17 and arrived in Kuala Lumpur when he was 25. He became Kapitan Cina in 1868, the third one, and served for 17 years until his death.

Each stamp set costs RM20 and can be obtained from the Kuala Lumpur and Selangor Chinese Assembly Hall.
